Opening

Review of Meeting Minutes

Utilities Budget Review

Don White, resident, presented a spreadsheet analyzing the Utilities budget over the years (attached). Don worked with Tom Raab, School Business Manager; Lincoln Heineman, Finance Director; and Chelsea Stevens, Town Accountant, to analyze the export of data from the Town's financial system. Don helped to find savings in the Town's utilities budget. The Committee thanked Don for his hard work.

Discussion of ATM Article 40

Ed Callahan and Mike Hoban, from the Hanover Mall, discussed Article 40 of the Annual Town Meeting warrant with the Committee. There are currently only five or six liquor licenses left in Town. This article requests thirteen additional licenses specifically for the Mall property. Ed discussed that this would help them while negotiating leases with potential future tenants.

Discussion of ATM Article 41

Steven Guard, Dana Altobello, and Brian Davidson discussed Article 41 – Amend Zoning Map with the Committee. They presented pictures and maps (attached). They still need to go before the Planning Board prior to the Annual Town Meeting.

Adjournment

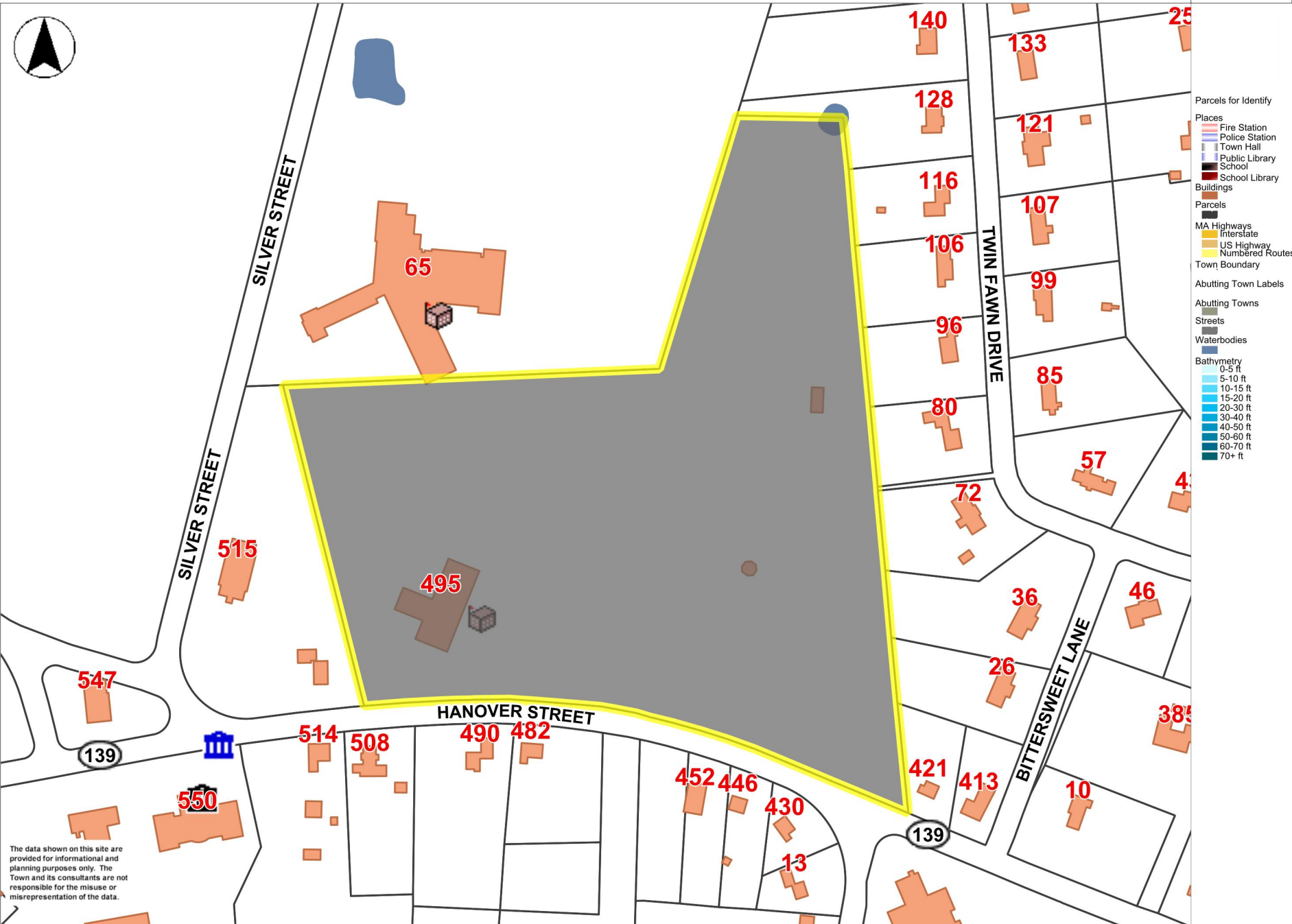
Steve Kmito made the motion to adjourn. This was seconded by Joan Port-Farwell. All were in favor and the meeting adjourned at 8:51 p.m.

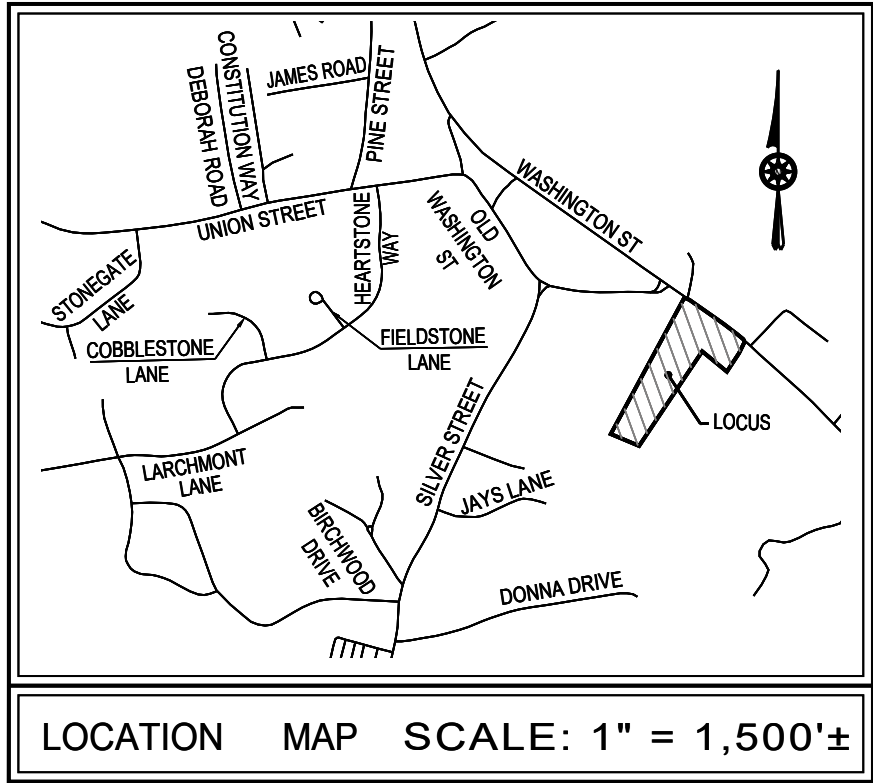

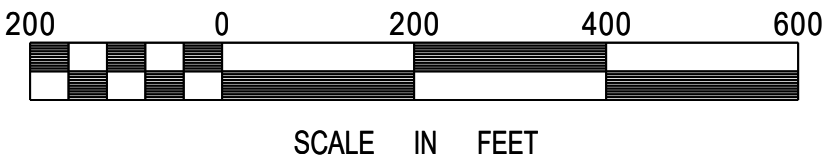
