Articles 10 – General Fund Operating Budget

The Committee went through each line item and had discussions about possible changes/reductions. An excel spreadsheet showing changes/reductions was completed during this process (*see below*). The Committee discussed and added \$30,000 for the cost of an environmental attorney for the fireworks site. Chairman Ted Hickey stated that this cost may be reimbursed by the State; however, it is not certain at this point. The Committee discussed and removed \$55,651 from the finance department's salaries budget. Also the Committee reduced the finance department's anticipated expenses by \$40,160. The Committee discussed and approved of the library's budget reduction of \$15,024. The Committee discussed the school special education funds and added \$500,000 to public school for this expense. \$72,398 was added to the South Shore Vo-tech budget. The Committee discussed the Facilities Department's salaries and expenses. These budgets were reduced by \$50,000 and \$10,000 respectively. The Committee discussed the DPW salaries and reduced this budget by \$20,000. The Committee discussed the funds in the cemetery graves and foundations account. Gavin Little-Gill suggested more than \$16,000 could be removed since the balance is \$180,000. The Committee put forward the sum of \$65,000. Angela Blanchard expressed concern that this sum was too large. Emmanuel Dockter made a motion to adjust the General Fund Operating Budget as seen in the drafted spreadsheet (*see below*). This was seconded by Jerry O'Hearn. All were in favor, and the motion passed.

Discussion with Chris Martin – Sylvester Redevelopment Committee

Chris Martin met with the Committee to discuss <u>Article 31 – Sylvester Reuse Study.</u> Mr. Martin explained that the Sylvester Redevelopment Committee reviewed and reduced the funds requested for this article to \$15,000. These funds will be used to hire a consultant to put in place federal tax credits that will make the Sylvester School more attractive to potential buyers. The building will be sold after the Center School addition is completed and will likely be converted to housing. The land will be retained by the Town and leased to the building owners. The Committee thanked Mr. Martin for his time, and he departed at 8:14 pm.

Joan Port-Farwell made a motion to adjourn. This was seconded by Emmanuel Dockter. All were in favor, and the meeting adjourned at 9:24 pm.
