Update from the Public Health Nurse: Mrs. Nancy funder updated the board on the updated food code that Massachusetts has adopted. The 2013 Food Code is now in use, replacing the 1999 food code that had been in use. Mrs. Mahoney made a motion to approve the usage of the 2013 food code, Mr. Dougherty seconded. Mrs. Funder stated that the food establishment definition has changed and gas stations and other locations that sell prepackaged food could no longer be considered food establishments.

Fee Schedule/Inspections: The board will look into making changes to the fee schedule and perhaps changing the frequency of inspections to certain places, depending on what type of product they sell.

926 Broadway Betterment Program: Mrs. Mahoney motioned to approve for a partial payment for the engineering services done at 926 Broadway for Robert and Carolyn Frattalone. Work must be completed on the installation of the system within the next calendar year. Mr. Dougherty seconded the motion.

Meeting Dates: Going forward, after the January 15th 2019 meeting, the Board will be switching its meeting schedule to every other Monday. The Board has decided on meeting months through February and they will be Monday January 28th 2019, Monday February 11th 2019, and Monday February 25th 2018.

Goals: The board would like to move forward with their Bodyworks regulations as well as looking into banning smoking/vaping flavors.
