

These are the minutes from the May 17, 2022 meeting of the Hanover Board of Health. Present were Mr. John Dougherty - Chairman, Ms. Diane Sawin – Board Member, Ms. Kathleen Dauphinais – Board Member, and Mr. William Barrett – Asst. Health Agent, Ms. Ann lee – CDMI Director, Ms. Vanessa O'Connor – Selectboard, Mr. Steve Louko – Selectboard/AHT, Mr. Tom Burke – AHT

Having a quorum, Mr. Dougherty motioned to open the meeting at 4:35 p.m.

Affordable Housing Trust Septic Program – The Board of Health met with representatives from the Affordable Housing Trust regarding a program that the AHT is proposing for a septic loan program. The AHT is proposing a program in which a homeowner can receive a loan in order to upgrade their septic system to a current Title 5 system. This was a discussion at this time and the Board of Health and the Affordable Housing Trust may meet again when more details and figures are more established.

Hanover Day Food Vendor Fee Waiver: Ms. Dauphinais motioned to waive the food vendor fee for Rockwell amusements as part of the Hanover Day celebration, Ms. Sawin second the motion all in favor.

Bodywork Application/Fee: Ms. Sawin motioned to accept the Bodywork Application as written and to set fees consistent with other Body Art establishments. The Fees work Bodywork will be \$200 for the establishment annually and \$75 per practitioner annually. Ms. Dauphinais second the motion all in favor.

Board of Health Chair: Ms. Dauphinais motioned to appoint Ms. Diane Sawin as the Chair of the Board of Health, Mr. Dougherty second.
