

These are the minutes from the May 3, 2023 meeting of the Hanover Board of Health. Present were Ms. Diane Sawin - Chair, Mr. John Dougherty – Board Member, Ms. Kim Dixon – Health Director, Mr. William Barrett – Asst. Health Agent, Ms. Kathleen Mahoney- South Shore Tobacco Coordinator

Having a quorum, Ms. Sawin motioned to open the meeting at 4:04 p.m.

Health Agent Update:

110 Grill and Ryan's Amusements at Hanover crossing will both be opening soon. Inspections have been completed and training is in process. The new outdoor pool facilities at the YMCA are coming along and will be ready for the summer season.

Kim has been out working with commercial properties to get trash cleaned up from the parking lots after the winter. Fortunately we did not have a lot of snow therefore not a lot of trash was plowed into snow piles this year.

Kathleen Mahoney – South Shore Tobacco Coordinator – Discuss Fines and Suspensions:

Ms. Mahoney informed the board that during recent compliance checks for tobacco sales to a person under 21, 6 retailers in Town were found to have sold to an individual under age 21. The State regulation that the Hanover Board of Health has adopted states that these retailers shall be fined \$1,000 and these retailers shall receive a one day permit suspension for tobacco sales. A Hearing regarding these 6 violations will be held at the Board of Health Meeting on May 16th.
