New Business:

541 Webster Street – Terence McSweeney and William St. George came in front of the board regarding a 60 Gallon per Day restriction at the property at 541 Webster Street. Mr. McSweeney and Mr. St. George asked the board to allow a septic system at the minimum requirement to be allowed on the property per Title 5. Mr. Dougherty motioned to lift the 60 GPD restriction at 541 Webster street to allow for a minimum sized Title 5 Septic System to be installed at the property, Mrs. Mahoney second, all in favor.

Update from Nancy Funder, Public Health Nurse:

Camps:

The YMCA summer camp opened today; there will be a graduate nurse on staff and the camp and pools have been inspected.

The South Shore baseball camp opened today as well and has been inspected.

Hanover Day:

The Hanover Day food inspections were completed and they all went very well.

Hanover House of Pizza:

After several complaints about employees not wearing gloves, 7 Employees at Hanover House of Pizza have successfully completed remedial glove training.

Draft Bodywork Regulations: The Board discussed the draft bodywork regulations; the Board Members will review this draft and discuss these regulations further at the next meeting on June 24, 2019

Septic System Location Method: Mr. Dougherty made a motion to require the placement of a 4 inch piece of rebar at major septic system components in order to easily locate the major components. This method has been found to be most reliable in locating the system than alternative methods, Mrs. Mahoney second, all in favor.
