Meeting Minutes:

New Business

Town Manager: Mr. Joseph Colangelo, Town Manager, attended the BoH meeting to say hello and introduced himself to the Board. Mr. Dougherty mentioned the present issues in town that the board has been working on and also expressed the importance of a member being part of the hiring process for staffing in the future. Mr. Colangelo agreed that he would have a member of the board involved in the hiring of staff for the office.

ICS Training: Mrs. Mahoney has completed the ICS Trainings and the other members will be taking the necessary class or additional classes that are being offer.

Opioid Program – Mrs. Mahoney was going to reach out to the schools and area Health Offices to see what their needs may be or what educational information they give out to school kids. She also wanted to find out what groups may already exist and if we could join and combine with an already existing group.

Mosquito List: June 1st, we have begun our mosquito list for our residents. We will fax over a list to Plymouth County mosquito, located in Kingston. They will then make a route for their truck and spray mosquitoes between 2am – ½ hour before sunrise during the weekdays. They can spray each property 8 times this year. They will also maintain a no spray list for Hanover residents that do not want their yard sprayed.
