Business, Crafter and Civic Group Instructions

Thank you for your participation in the Hanover Cultural Council's 5th annual Hanover Day! We are very excited for this upcoming event and have been grateful for all of the interest by crafters, local businesses and civic organizations. I will send a complete schedule of events for the day during the week before the event. Instructions on set up times, directions and parking locations are listed below. The location for business/craft booths and civic tables is on the Sylvester Field (also called B. Everett Hall Field) Route 139, Hanover, MA. Please see directions to the field below.

Set Up Times/Locations:

All groups may arrive between 8 am and 10 am to set up their booths. Please check in at the Cultural Council representative at the field entrance to get your booth number and location. You will be able to park in the main parking lot while you are unloading your items but you will need to move your car to the designated parking lot after you unload. Please be courteous to others and unload as quickly as possible as there is limited parking in this area and many groups will be trying to set up during the same time.

Parking:

Parking spots will be available for crafters and groups behind the Sylvester Elementary School which is located just next to the field. After you unload your things please move your car to this lot. It is a very short walk back to the field from the parking area.

Food:

There will be food items sold on the field throughout the day and there will also be the "Taste of Hanover" taking place during mid-day for your convenience. The "Taste" will be held in the grove in the front of the field near the parking lot and will feature food from some fine restaurants in Hanover. Tickets will be available for \$5.00 and can be purchased at the entrance to the "Taste" area. Directions:

Take Rte. 93 to Route 3 South (towards Cape Cod) Take Exit 13 off of Rte. 3 South. Bear right at the lights at the end of the exit and proceed onto Route 53 South. You will pass the Hanover Mall on your left. Continue on Rte. 53 for approximately 3 miles -You will pass through 3 lights. After you see Shaw's Supermarket on your right you will see a sign for Rte. 139 W (Hanover Center/Brockton). Bear right onto Rte. 139 and travel 1 mile. Sylvester Field will be on your right hand side. You will see basketball courts, a playground, and Sylvester Elementary School at the field. Follow signs to parking/unloading area. If you see the Hanover Town Hall on your left you have gone too far. The physical address for GPS is 495 Hanover Street, Hanover, MA 02339.
