*Thank you for your interest in Hanover Day 2010. In order to make this a successful day for all groups involved we have set the following guidelines:*

- Please register your group's interest and idea with the Hanover Cultural by May 21, 2010. must ask that you do this so that we can try to avoid having multiple groups running the same event or selling the same items. The Cultural Council will review all requests and issue approvals/denials. All decisions made by the Cultural Council are final.*
- All groups who have interest in selling food are responsible for getting the proper permits from the Board of Health. You MUST have the proper permits in place before June 1, 2010 in order to sell food. If you do not have an approval by this date you will not be allowed to sell food.*
- Groups that plan events such as pony rides, moonwalk, dunk tank, etc. must have proper clearances and/ or permits from all applicable town officials.*
- It is the responsibility of the individual group to get any and all set up materials, i.e. tents, tables, chairs that are needed for their booth/event.*
- Each group must have their own staff of volunteers to run their event or booth.*
- There is limited electricity at the field which must be taken into consideration when planning your group's activity. You must submit a request for use of electricity by the May 21st deadline.*
- There is a \$30 table fee for all "for profit" vendors such as crafters. The table fee is waived for non-profit organizations and businesses who are not charging the public for their products or activity(we also ask that you provide a give away or free activity/demonstration in lieu of fee).*
- Please remember that this event takes place rain or shine. Please plan accordingly*
