

These are the minutes from the October 26, 2010 meeting of the Hanover Board of Health. Present were Mr. John Dougherty – Chair, Mr. Walter Moran – Board Member, Mrs. Lynn White – Board Member and Mr. Anthony Marino –Health Agent.

Having a quorum, Mr. Dougherty called the meeting to order at 6:00 p.m.

New Business:

Mrs. White moved to approve the October 12, 2010 minutes as written, Mr. Moran second, so voted unanimously.

Motion made by Mr. Moran to waive the 2010 food permit fees for Five Guys Burgers and apply fees already paid to the 2011 food permit cost, Ms. White second, so voted unanimously.

The Board members signed all the license and permits, reviewed correspondence and food inspection reports

Mr. Marino updated the board on relevant items to include closing the doors between the planning and health office, the complaint at Burger King and that he delivered the Certificate of Appreciation to Diane Edge at her home last week. Mr. Marino also updated the Board that we have received the new septic design for Friendly's restaurant but Jim Donovan did not suggest approval as he had two plus pages of comments that we will forward to the engineer so the corrections can be made.

Board discussed Hazardous Waste regulations and made a few minor changes to not mandate permits but instead require the establishments to report to the Board the hazardous materials that they are storing on site.

Ms. White moved to accept and approve amended Hazardous Waste Regulations with minor changes to Section's 1-12 and 1-13 as discussed in the meeting, Mr. Moran second, so voted unanimously. A summary of these regulations will be published in the local newspaper and a copy will be deposited in the office of the Town Clerk.

The Board reviewed and discussed the Town Report that was drafted by Donna Tramontana and Mr. Marino.

Mr. Moran moved to submit the Town Report for the Board of Health as drafted and include the updated quantities of H1N1 vaccine that was administered and the number of communicable diseases that were reported to the State, Ms. White second, so voted unanimously.

Mr. Dougherty informed the Board that he would be on vacation from November 2-16, 2010 and that Walter Moran would be the acting chairman during this time frame. Mr. Dougherty would also like to be informed of any emergency during this time frame via his cell phone.
