

These are the minutes from the May 25, 2010 meeting of the Hanover Board of Health. Present were Mr. John Dougherty – Chair, Mr. Walter Moran – Board Member, Mrs. Lynn White – Board Member, Mr. Anthony Marino – Acting Health Agent and Ms. Donna Tramontana – Administrative Assistant.

Having a quorum, Mr. Dougherty called the meeting to order at 6:00 p.m.

Old Business:

1. Mrs. White moved to approve the minutes from the May 11, 2010 meeting, Mr. Moran second, so voted unanimously.

The Board discussed the Health Living Expo. to be held on June 26th at Riley Hall, and agreed that Event Applications must be completed by the event planner and any food vendors, along with the fees noted on the Board of Health fee schedule.

6:15 – Appointment – 33R Water Street – Mr. Dougherty moved to grant a variance to Mr. Holmes for his property at 33R Water Street, to allow a construction of a new garage to be 5.5 feet to the current leaching field, with the installation of a poly. barrier between the new foundation and the leaching field, Mr. Moran second, so voted unanimously.

6:30 – Appointment – 109 Bardin Street – Mr. Moran moved to allow the septic tank repair for H2O loading, for 109 Bardin Street, as described in a letter from Engineer, Mr. Gary James, and allow a crushed stone driveway over part of the leaching field, as presented on the design. Also, driveway is to remain crushed stone and Mr. Hallett is to have Mr. James place his engineered stamp on his letter and resubmit it to the Health Office, Mrs. White second, so voted unanimously.

2. Mr. Marino updated the Board on a housing issue. The Board would like Mr. Marino to draft a letter for Town Council to review and approve and then the Board Members would sign it.
3. Mr. Marino discussed potentially contaminated fill at a residential property on Old Town Way and on Washington Street at the Village property. Mr. Marino spoke with the homeowners on Old Town Way about testing the fill. The homeowner then spoke with the contractor who placed it there. The contractor voluntarily offered to remove it from the site. The Board would like the large pile on the Washington Street property tested. Mr. Marino will consult with Town Council and draft a letter, the Board will sign it. Mr. Moran asked about potentially contaminated soil at the building owned by the Drinkwater Firefighters Association on King Street. Mr. Marino will go to the site and make an assessment.

Mr. Marino updated the Board on a rooster complaint on Twin Fawn Drive.

Plans:

1169 Hanover Street: Mrs. White moved to approve the submitted septic plan for 1160 Hanover Street, dated 5/12/10, as submitted by McGlone Ent., with the variances as noted on the plan, Mr. Moran second, so voted unanimously. Deed Restriction.

Lot 4B Whiting Street: Approved as submitted

1525 Hanover Street: The tight tank was approved for Industrial Waste only. The Engineer to make minor changes to plan, as written on Mr. Donovan review sheet.

The Board reviewed Mrs. Funder's food inspection reports.

Permits, Licenses and Bills signed

Mrs. White moved to adjourn, Mr. Moran second, so voted unanimously. Meeting adjourned at 8:10 p.m.
