

These are the minutes from the May 4, 2010 meeting of the Hanover Board of Health. Present were Ms. Diane Edge – Chair, Mr. John Dougherty – Board Member, Mr. Walter Moran – Board Member and Ms. Donna Tramontana – Administrative Assistant. Mr. Anthony Marino – Acting Health Agent arrived near the end of the meeting.

Having a quorum, Ms. Edge called the meeting to order at 9:00 a.m.
Ms. Edge stated she was audio recording the meeting as a resident/citizen.
Mr. Marino was absent.

7 Days Convenience – Ms. Edge moved allow 7 Days Convenience to sell tobacco products only after they have received their D.O.R. approval, Mr. Moran second, so voted unanimously.

Ms. Edge was happy with the Board's decision to require an observation hole at Lot 4 Lally Farm. Groundwater was 8 inches higher then when previous percs were done approximately 6 years ago.

Ms. Edge updated the Board on the Sharps kiosk. The kiosk was moved over to the Fire Station this morning. Mr. Blanchard has asked that the Board not advertise the hours of operation until he can train his employees. He would like to hold off until after town elections. Ms. Edge wanted it noted that the Selectmen put a halt on the kiosk and she feels that the firemen should have been trained when they knew the kiosk was going to be placed over there.

1. Ms. Edge moved to approve the April 27, 2010 minutes, Mr. Dougherty second, so voted unanimously.

Ms. Edge wanted it stated for the record that she does not feel the Board is dysfunctional and feels they do a good job. Ms. Edge reminded the Board that they are there to protect the public health and that well being clinics are handled by the Hanover Visiting Nurses and the Board would be stepping on them if they tried to hold these types of clinics.

If she is not re-elected, Ms. Edge would like the Board to pursue the Betterment loan program. She has information she will pass along to them.

She also wanted it noted for the record that since the Animal Regulations were revised there have been no animal complaints from residents.

Mr. Golemme and Mr. Marino went out to the Plain Street property and there is now sufficient lighting inside the barn.

Mr. Marino arrived at 9:57 a.m.

Ms. Edge moved to adjourn, Mr. Moran second, so voted unanimously. Meeting adjourned at 10:16 a.m.
