

These are the minutes from the June 8, 2010 meeting of the Hanover Board of Health. Present were Mr. John Dougherty – Chair, Mr. Walter Moran – Board Member, Mrs. Lynn White – Board Member, Mr. Anthony Marino – Acting Health Agent and Ms. Donna Tramontana – Administrative Assistant.

Having a quorum, Mr. Dougherty called the meeting to order at 6:00 p.m.

Old Business:

1. Mrs. White moved to approve the 5/25/10 minutes, Mr. Moran second, so voted unanimously.

Mrs. White opened a line of communication with Victor Diniak regarding residents that have unwanted medication they need to disposal of. Mrs. White asked the Board if it was okay if she pursued this with Mr. Diniak and CVS. Mr. Moran and Mr. Dougherty were happy to have Mrs. White look into this. Mrs. White will contact CVS and update the Board at the next meeting.

Deed Restriction.

1433 Broadway – Mrs. White moved to accept the septic plan for 1433 Broadway, dated 5/19/10, submitted by McKenzie Engineering for Arthur and Claire Hassett, with the variance(s) as noted on the plan, Mr. Moran second, so voted unanimously. Deed Restriction.
