

**These are the minutes from the July 26, 2011 meeting of the Hanover Board of Health. Present were Mr. Walter Moran – Chair, John Dougherty – Board Member, Mrs. Lynn White – Board Member, Mr. Arthur Ceurvels – Assist. Health Agent and Ms. Donna Tramontana – Administrative Assistant.**

Having a quorum, Mr. Moran called the meeting to order at 6:30 p.m.

Permits were signed.

**Plans:**

**353 Circuit Street** – Approved as submitted

**338 Circuit Street** – Mrs. White moved to approve the submitted septic repair plan for 338 Circuit Street, designed by Grady Associates, dated July 12, 2011, with the variances noted on the plan, Mr. Dougherty second, so voted unanimously.

**The Elms, Sugar Maple** – Mr. Dougherty moved to approve the submitted septic repair plan for The Elms, Sugar Maple Circle, designed by Grady Consulting, dated July 7, 2011 and revised July 21, 2011, with the variances as noted on the plan, Mrs. White second, so voted unanimously.

**63 Massasoit Lane** – Approved as submitted

**New Business:**

1. Mrs. Dougherty moved to approve the July 12, 2011 minutes as written, Mrs. White second, so voted unanimously.

The Board discussed the Selectmen's request to meet with them at the next Selectmen's meeting on August 8<sup>th</sup>, to discuss smoking on Town own property. Mr. Dougherty would like to know who is the Board of Health liaison from the Selectmen Board and would like him/her to attend their next meeting to discuss what the Selectmen are proposing.

Mr. Marino was not present at the meeting, but gave an update to the Board in an email dated July 26, 2011.

At the previous meeting the Board asked Ms. Tramontana to research the cost of the Pneumonia and Shingles vaccine to possibly offer this to the residents at cost. The cost of each dose would be approximately \$66.00 for Pneumonia and \$180.00 for the Shingles/Zooster vaccine. The Board agreed during these economical hard times the cost to residents would be too high. Therefore, they have decided not to move forward with this.

The Board reviewed the final letter to be sent to the Hanover restaurants regarding Healthy Hanover Choices. Ms. Tramontana will create a form to be sent with the letter.

The Board discussed a recent article in The Patriot Ledger regarding tick borne illnesses and would like to publish one in The Hanover Mariner.

Mrs. White commented that the State of Massachusetts is going to mandate school lunches to be health.
