

These are the minutes from the August 23, 2011 meeting of the Hanover Board of Health. Present were Mr. Walter Moran – Chair, John Dougherty – Board Member, Mrs. Lynn White – Board Member, Mr. Anthony Marino – Health Agent, Mr. Arthur Ceurvets – Assist Health Agent and Ms. Donna Tramontana – Administrative Assistant.

Mr. Moran would be arriving late and asked the meeting start at regular time. Having a quorum, Mr. Dougherty called the meeting to order at 6:30 p.m.

New Business:

1. Mrs. White moved to approve the August 9, 2011 minutes as written, Mr. Dougherty second, so voted unanimously.

6:40 – Appointment – Dan Pallotta and Susan Setterland were in attendance to discuss smoking on Town owned property. Mrs. White explained in April 2011 the Board of Health already decided that smoking would be restricted within 25 feet of doors and windows of any Town owned building. Mrs. Setterland is not in favor of that; she would like no smoking to be allowed in front of the Town Hall, on the ramp or in any visible location. She would like a designated smoking area for employees. Mr. Pallotta would like all Town owned property to be smoke free. Mr. Dougherty stated having employees leave the grounds each time they wanted to smoke was not a good idea either. Mrs. White explained that the State has already adopted a policy that requires smokers to be 25 feet from entrances/exits and windows and the Board felt this was sufficient and adopted the same policy. She also explained the downsides to a designated smoking area. Mrs. White feels that the Board of Health's concerns are with public health, not appearance, and if the Town Hall wanted a designated smoking area it could be done through town hall policy. Mrs. White will attend the Selectmen's meeting on August 29th. Mr. Moran arrived at 6:55

Plans:

148/152 Broadway – Mrs. White moved to approve the plan submitted for 148/152 Broadway, designed by McGlone Enterprises, revised date 8/22/11, with the variances as noted on the plan, provided legal documents are completed and filed at the Registry of Deeds prior to issuance of the Certificate of Compliance and approval by D.E.P., Mr. Dougherty second, so vote unanimously. Deed Restriction.

204 Grove Street – Mr. Dougherty moved to approve the plan for 204 Grove Street, designed by Morse Engineering, plan dated 8/12/11 and revised 8/22/11, with the variances as noted on the plan, Mrs. White second, so voted unanimously. Deed Restriction

285 Circuit Street – Mrs. White moved to approve the installation of the White Knight system at 285 Circuit Street, designed by Watchusett Engineering, plans dated 6/28/11 with the variances as noted on the plan, Mr. Dougherty second, so voted unanimously.

656 Broadway – Approved as submitted

Mr. Marino gave his update:

- Mr. Ceurvets investigated a complaint regarding Nautical Mile. Complaint was founded. Mr. Marino will follow-up.
- Mr. Ceurvets investigated a complaint of septic odor on Whiting Street. Odor was not detected at time of inspection, but complainant was advised to call if odor was prevalent.

Mr. Moran asked if any action had been taken with Harold Watt's property. Mr. Marino said he will follow-up and advise.

- McKenzie Engineering is working on the septic system at Charles David Salon. There was another complaint. Mr. Marino went out and the system required pumping.\
- Flu clinic dates are to be decided soon. Mrs. White would like to know dates so she can plan to volunteer.

Mrs. White to sit with Tony on 8/31 to draft a certificate for participant of Healthy Hanover Restaurant Choices.

Mr. Dougherty would like to spend 15 minutes each meeting reviewing emergency planning. He would also like a handout drafted for restaurants to help them if there is power loss.

Permits/Licenses were signed

Mrs. White moved to adjourn, Mr. Dougherty second, so voted unanimously. Meeting adjourned at 8:15 p.m.
