

These are the minutes from the September 28, 2010 meeting of the Hanover Board of Health. Present were Mr. John Dougherty – Chair, Mr. Walter Moran – Board Member, Mrs. Lynn White – Board Member, and Ms. Donna Tramontana – Administrative Assistant. Mr. Anthony Marino –Health Agent was absent.

Having a quorum, Mr. Dougherty called the meeting to order at 6:00 p.m.
There were no appointments.

New Business:

1. Mrs. White moved to approve the September 14, 2010 minutes as written, Mr. Moran second, so voted unanimously.
2. Mr. Dougherty read the proposed letter regarding Healthy Menu Choices at Hanover Restaurants. Mr. Dougherty recommended sending out a press release regarding Trans. Fats, Carbohydrates, etc. Mrs. White moved the Board approve the letter as presented, printed on Board of Health letterhead, to be sent out in October and to be returned by December 1st, Mr. Moran second, so voted unanimously. Mrs. White will gather information for the FDA website and a list of nutritional consultants in the area willing to work with restaurants.

Mr. Dougherty read into the minutes Mr. Marino's Health Agent update. Mr. Dougherty wanted it noted for the record that Lynn White was a huge help on the unwanted medication drop-off day.

Mr. Dougherty read into the minutes the letter from Witsop, regarding 840 Washington Street. Mr. Marino had stated he would address this matter under his Zoning Officer capacity. Mr. Moran would like Town Council to review the letter. The Board would like Mr. Marino to continue to keep them updated on this issue.

3. The Board reviewed the Hazardous Waste Regulations and agreed they need to do further research.

Plans:

1269 Broadway – Approved as submitted

597 Webster Street – Mrs. White moved to accept the plan for 597 Webster Street, dated September 16, 2010, revised September 28, 2010 with the variances as noted on the plan, and for plan to be resubmitted with perc. test pit locations and the existing septic systems noted on the plan, Mr. Moran second, so voted unanimously. Deed Restriction.

37 Old Town Way – Approved as submitted

Mr. Moran moved to keep the Flu clinic fees as they were last year, no charge for Hanover residents and \$5.00 for non-residents, Mrs. White second, so voted unanimously.
