Working cooperatively with the Massachusetts Department of Environmental Protection (MA DEP), the Town of Hanover is providing notification of a temporary closure of town owned Conservation land on the trails located on the former National Fireworks site approximately between May 29 and June 30, 2017. The purpose of the closure is to restrict access as site prep work and cleanup work gets underway.

This is a long awaited and welcomed milestone at this site. Town leaders, particularly the Board of Selectmen and the Fireworks Site Focus Committee, have worked tirelessly for several years to get us to this point. We are pleased that significant progress is being made and that actual cleanup has commenced.

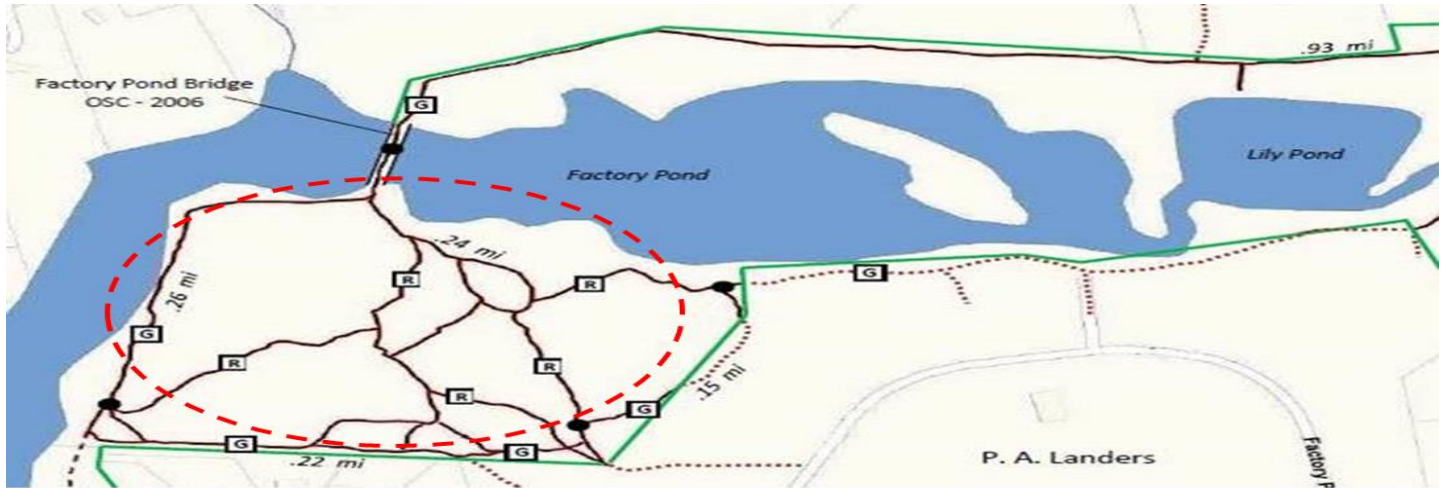
