

These are the minutes from the March 24, 2015 meeting of the Hanover Board of Health. Present were Mr. Richard Farwell– Chair, Mrs. Lynn White – Board Member, Mrs. Robin McLaughlin –Board Member, Mr. Anthony Marino – Health Agent, and Mr. Arthur Ceurvets – Assistant Health Agent.

Having a quorum, Mr. Farwell called the meeting to order at 6:00 p.m.

Meeting Minutes:

Mrs. McLaughlin moved to approve the March 10, 2015 minutes, Mrs. White second the motion; so voted unanimously.

New Business

67 Washington Street Potable Well Application – Caleb Estabrooks & Elizabeth Johansen

Ms. Johansen reported that they met with representatives of 54 Old Shipyard Lane as suggested to discuss an alternative siting of the proposed well (for 67 Washington St.) and the proposed septic system (at 54 Old Shipyard Lane). However, the two parties failed reach to an agreement. After much discussion and with the location of the proposed well still within a 100' of the proposed septic system for 54 Old Shipyard Lane; Mrs. McLaughlin moved to deny the private drinking well permit for 67 Washington Street, at this time, Mrs. White second the motion; so voted unanimously.
