Foreman – Transfer Station

The Town of Hanover, Department of Public Works has a position available for a full-time foreman at the Hanover Transfer Station. This position requires a high school diploma or equivalent, a Class A CDL, and a Class 2B hoisting engineer's license. The pay scale is \$23.99 to \$25.93 per hour plus applicable license stipends of \$0.8621 per hour for the CDL and hoisting licenses.

The successful candidate will be responsible for the operation and maintenance of the Hanover Transfer Station including management of the flow of materials in and out of the facility. Management of Transfer Station staff and significant interaction with the public are integral parts of this position. Attention to detail is required. Prior experience in solid waste management and familiarity with Massachusetts solid waste regulations is highly desirable. The position requires physical work inside and outside in all weather conditions.

If selected for employment, the candidate shall undergo a pre-employment physical which shall include screening for drugs and alcohol and shall be subject to random drug and alcohol testing once hired.

This is a 40 hour per week position with significant opportunities for overtime. The schedule is Friday – Tuesday (closed Wednesday and Thursday), 8:00 am – 4:30 pm. Participation in the Town's snow and ice operation as well as off-shift emergency and planned maintenance activities to transfer station and other public works assets are integral parts of this position.
