SEASONAL INFLUENZA CLINICS

Flu is unpredictable. Even healthy children and adults can get flu and it can be serious. Protect yourself and those around you by getting your flu vaccine this season. Flu vaccination is the best protection available against flu.

Everyone 6 months and older should get a yearly flu vaccine to reduce the risk of flu related illness, hospitalization, and even death.

The Hanover Board of Health has scheduled its annual public flu clinics to be held at the
Hanover Senior Center, 665 Center Street, Hanover:

Monday, September 25, 2017

5:30 pm – 7:30 pm

Monday, October 2, 2017

1:30 pm – 3:30 pm

Please note:

We will be offering 2 formulations of flu vaccine this year:

- High-Dose (HD) specifically for ages 65 and older, a trivalent vaccine formulated for older adults
- Quadrivalent vaccine which provides protection against 4 strains of flu virus for ages 6 months and up

All persons will be asked to present an insurance card which will cover the cost of the flu shot.

No one will be turned away on the basis of insurance eligibility.
