Ms. Minasi brought the water records for the barbershop which showed to the Board that they are well within the limit of 200 gallons per day on their septic system. With this information, Mr. Dougherty motioned to allow the barbershop to add 2 additional chairs, Mrs. Mahoney seconded, all in favor.
