## New Business:

Mrs. White moved to approve the July 12, 2011 minutes as written, Mr. Dougherty second, so voted unanimously.

Mr. Ceurvels provided an overview and status of Community Septic Management Program.

Mr. Marino reported that the Selectmen were not available to meet with the Board at this time, due to previous commitments. A representative from the Board of Selectmen will attend the August 23<sup>rd</sup> meeting to discuss smoking on Town own property.

Mr. Marino informed the Board that a Montillio's Bakery is planning to open at 778 Washington Street (previously a Mexican restaurant). This facility will serve as a satellite bakery; no baking will be done on site.

Mr. Marino gave an update on a housing complaint he received from a tenant of 711 Washington Street. Property owner Mr. John Benevides of 245 Curtis Mill Lane was also present at the meeting. Mr. Marino conducted an initial inspection of the property and cited a few housing code violations. A re-inspection was completed today and the violations had been corrected. Mr. Marino also stated that the building was in good condition. The complainant was invited to address the board but failed to attend. The board has decided to take no further action at this time.
