

**These are the minutes from the June 12, 2012 meeting of the Hanover Board of Health. Present were Mrs. Lynn White – Chair, Mr. John Dougherty – Board Member, Mr. Richard Farwell – Board Member, Mr. Anthony Marino –Health Agent and Ms. Kimberly Dixon – Administrative Assistant.**

Having a quorum, Mrs. White called the meeting to order at 6:00 p.m.

New Business:

1. Mr. Dougherty moved to approve the May 29, 2012 minutes as amended, Mr. Farwell second, so voted unanimously.
2. Mr. Marino announced that Ms. Kimberly Dixon will be the new Administrative Assistant for the Board of Health
