No Permits or Licenses were submitted

Mr. Marino's update:

Mr. Marino submitted the Town Report- Board of Health section for review and Mr. Dougherty approved the report and Mr. Farwell seconded, so voted unanimously.

Mr. Marino informed the Board of a View permit update scheduled next week that will improve the use and look of the inspection report. Mrs. White would like to have the name of the Business on the inspection report to come across on each sheet.

Mr. Marino and the Board discussed the issue of the beaver dam on the Colby Phillips property. Mrs. White moved in accordance with Massachusetts General Law, Ch. 131, Section 80A for the Board of Health to issue an emergency permit to alleviate the threat to human health and safety that the dam is causing. The Board stipulated that the Conservation Commission will present their plan to the Board of Health prior to implementing their plan. Mr. Farwell seconded, so voted unanimously.
