645 Center Street

She discussed possibly transferring ownership of the property to the Affordable Housing Trust. Committee members would like to meet with the Affordable Housing Trust prior to making any further recommendations.

The Committee discussed the issue of the shrubs around the farmhouse and asked the Community Preservation Coordinator to get the shrubs cleared either through the DPW or by hiring an outside contractor.

Barn Restoration Project

Mr. Molyneaux encouraged the Committee to watch a video of a presentation done by Stephen O'Shaughnessy about the history of the barn deconstruction and its value as an historic resource.

The Committee received an update on the CPA funds available for allocation at Town Meeting in May 2012. The Committee asked the Coordinator to contact Jennifer Petit, Finance Director and have her come to the next CPC meeting to give an overview of CPA funds.
