The following minutes are from the meeting of the Hanover Community Preservation Committee held on Monday, January 25, 2016 in Hanover Town Hall.

The following Committee members were present: William Scarpelli, Mary Dunn, April Manupelli, James Coulter, Richard Deluca and Jonathan Chu.

The Chairman William Scarpelli opened the meeting at 6:12 p.m.

The CPC reviewed the articles that were being submitted to the Annual Town meeting Warrant for May 2016 and voted as follows:

- Article to appropriate \$50,000 to the Veterans Honor Guard Committee for the Veterans Memorial Garden project April Manupelli motioned to recommend the article as written. Richard Deluca seconded the motion. So voted unanimously.
- Article to appropriate \$20,000 to the Hanover Open Space Committee for the Open Space Plan 2016-2021 James Coulter motioned to recommend the article as written. William Scarpelli seconded the motion. So voted unanimously.
- Article to appropriate \$9,200 to the Hanover Open Space Committee for the Trail Expansion and Improvement project William Scarpelli seconded motioned to recommend the article as written. Richard Deluca seconded the motion. So voted unanimously.
- Article to appropriate \$10,000 to Robert Murray, Facilities Engineering Manager for the Stetson House Barn repair Jonathan Chu motioned to recommend the article as written. Richard Deluca seconded the motion. So voted unanimously.
- Article to appropriate \$200,000 to Town of Hanover for the installation of central air condition Mary Dunn motioned to <u>deny</u> the article as written. Jonathan Chu seconded the motion. So voted unanimously.
- Article to appropriate \$8,960 to Town of Hanover for the restoration of World War II Roll of Honor Mary Dunn motioned to recommend the article as written. Jonathan Chu seconded the motion. So voted unanimously.
- Article to appropriate \$5,000 to Town of Hanover for the restoration of Hanover Anchor and Plow James Coulter motioned to <u>deny</u> the article as written. Mary Dunn seconded the motion. So voted unanimously.

• Article to appropriate \$110,091 to the Affordable Housing Trust – Jonathan Chu motioned to recommend the article as written. James Coulter seconded the motion. So voted unanimously.

William Scarpelli made a motion to adjourn at 7:40 p.m. Mary Dunn seconded the motion. All others voted in favor.
