II. <u>PUBLIC HEARING</u>:

1. **BL 20-17, 140 Dillingham Way**- RDA- for construction of room addition in BZ to BVW PRESENT: Mr. and Mrs. Mancini

DISCUSSION: Mr. Mancini presented a plan dated 2/06/2020 showing the removal of a room addition from a single family dwelling, wooden deck, and outside stairway, and the construction of a new 20 ft. x 20 ft. room addition, new wooden deck, replacement of 12 ft. x 10 ft. wooden shed, proposed at >50 ft. from an on-site Bordering Vegetated Wetland (BVW). Also requested for safety reasons was the removal of up to six (6) storm damaged and diseased trees with cutting at ground level.

VOTE: Upon a motion and second made by Members Sennett and Vaille it was voted 3-0-0 to close the hearing and issue a Negative #3 Determination of Applicability.

2. BL 20-18, 24 Chestnut Circle- RDA- for septic upgrade in BZ to BVW

PRESENT: Robert Carlezon PE, Grady Consulting, LLC

DISCUSSION: Mr. Carlezon presented a plan dated 2/20/2020 showing the abandonment of a failed septic system 35 ft. from an on-site Bordering Vegetated Wetland (BVW). The plan also showed the installation of a new Title V rated residential septic disposal system 65 ft. from the BVW. VOTE: Upon a motion and second made by Members Sennett and Vaille it was voted 3-0-0 to close the hearing and issue a Negative #3 Determination of Applicability.

3. BL 20-19, SE 31-1208, 637 Washington St.- Starland- ANRAD- for wetland review only

PRESENT: None

VOTE: Upon a motion and second made by Members Sennett and Vaille it was voted 3-0-0 to continue the hearing to April 1, 2020 as per the applicant's request.

4. **BL 20-20, 219 Winter St.**- RDA- for construction of salt shed and access roadway in BZ to BVW and RFA PRESENT: Deb Keller PE, Merrill Engineers and Land Surveyors

DISCUSSION: Ms. Keller presented a plan dated 2/10/2020 showing the installation of a paved access way off Ames Way in outer riparian to Torrey Brook, >100 ft. from on-site wetlands, and out of (>200 ft. from) riverfront area to a tributary of the Drinkwater River. It was explained that this work was in association with the construction of a storage shed for roadway salt that was proposed out of both riverfront areas, not in FEMA flood zone, and out of all buffer areas to the on-site Bordering Vegetated Wetlands.

VOTE: Upon a motion and second made by Sennett and Vaille, it was voted 3-0-0 to close the hearing and issue a Negative #2 Determination of Applicability.
