Subject: Public Notice of Proposed Aerial Pesticide Applications during the 2020 Season

The following is offered as an explanation/clarification of the enclosed published notice:

- 1) We are, and always have been, required by 333 CMR 13.05 to publish notice of our intent on this subject in a newspaper of general circulation prior to application.
- 2) Recent changes in the Regulations have enabled us to streamline this process by publishing notice a single time, in February, for the entire season.
- The notice is intended to convey that we <u>MAY</u> DO AERIAL LARVICIDING, <u>IF</u> <u>APPROPRIATE</u>, subject to severity of larval populations and acceptable flying conditions. It does <u>NOT</u> mandate us to make applications.
- 4) If we feel, as the season progresses, that aerial applications should be made in your town, we will re-notify you as soon as possible in advance, stating the date, time and location.
- 5) As always, if you have any questions, please feel free to contact us.
