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TOWN AND CHAMBER SET DATE FOR STATE OF THE TOWN

Working together to strengthen the partnership between the Town of Hanover and its vital business community, the Town and the Hanover Chamber of Commerce have jointly announced the scheduling of the 2016 “State of the Town” address.

The address will be held at the Hanover Town Hall on Thursday, February 25th, 2016, at 7:30 A.M. The breakfast will include an update on Town affairs by Chairman of the Board of Selectmen Brian Barthelmes and Town Manager Troy Clarkson. State and Regional elected officials will also continue their tradition of updating the public on legislative issues. Chamber representatives and local business leaders have been invited to attend and provide an update on the business outlook in 2016 and their partnership with the town on collaborative efforts to enhance this important sector of the local economy.
