The Town of Hanover released the following statement regarding political signs today:

The Town of Hanover's Sign Bylaw states that political signs (not more than one per candidate per lot) are permitted for a period of three weeks before any election to three days after. This local law was enacted in 1974. This means that for the upcoming election on November 6th, political signs should not be installed until October 16th. We believe that education is the best form of enforcement. The Department of Community Development and Municipal Inspections and the Town Clerk's Office cordially ask everyone in town to voluntarily follow these rules.
