NOTICE OF PUBLIC HEARING**

Notice is hereby given that the Bylaw Review Committee of the Town of Hanover will hold a Public Hearing on Thursday, April 13, 2023 at 7:00 p.m. in the First Floor Hearing Room of Hanover Town Hall located at 550 Hanover Street, Hanover, MA 02339. The Hearing may be attended in person or remotely. Remote Access Instructions shall be provided at the top of the Bylaw Review Committee's Agenda for April 13, 2023 which shall be posted at <https://www.hanover-ma.gov/bylaw-review-committee> prior to the meeting. The purpose of this Public Hearing is to hear testimony and comment from interested persons relative to proposed amendments to the General Bylaws of the Town of Hanover. Said amendments are to be included as Articles on the Warrant for consideration and action at the 2023 Hanover Annual Town Meeting. After this Public Hearing the Committee will, as required, vote its recommendations on the proposed Articles and report them to the Town of Hanover Advisory Committee.

There are six (6) Bylaw Amendment Articles proposed for consideration at the 2023 Hanover Annual Town Meeting. A summary of these Articles is provided below. Copies of the text of such Articles are available for review by interested parties in the Offices of the Town Clerk, 550 Hanover St., Hanover, MA., 02339 during Town Clerk office hours. The Articles listed below may not be the same as those that appear on the final Warrant for the 2023 Hanover Annual Town Meeting, and are inserted herein for convenience and discussion purposes only.

Summary of Annual Town Meeting Articles Proposing Amendments to the Bylaws:

- Article 14. Amend General Bylaws - §4-14 to Create the Position of Deputy Police Chief
- Article 39. Amend General Bylaws - §6-9 - Sign Bylaw, Article 5 - Petition Article to Prohibit Digital Message Boards, Internally Illuminated and Moving Signs
- Article 40. Amend General Bylaws - §6-9 - Sign Bylaw, Article 5 – Revised Petition Article to Prohibit Digital Message Boards, Flashing and Moving Signs
- Article 41. Amend General Bylaws - §6-9 - Sign Bylaw, Article 5 – Delete Language under Section 5.1.1
- Article 50. Amend General Bylaw §6-14 – Wetlands Protection
- Article 51. Amend General Bylaw §4-12 - Conservation Commission
