The Commission is to hear the petition of Michael Smith, 38 Old Shipyard Ln., Hanover, for a Notice of Intent filed by Atlantic Coast Engineering, LLC, Scituate, MA Phone: 781-378-2593, for proposed work described as the demolition of a house, expansion of paved driveway, construction of a new house, garage, and associated site work with erosion control and limit of work located within riverfront to the North River and within 100 ft. of a bordering vegetated wetland (BVW). This parcel is located at 38 Old Shipyard Ln. and is designated on Hanover Assessor's Maps as Plan 58, Lot 41.
