Prequalification from MassDOT for Item 9: Pavement Markings is required.

<u>Town of Hanover – Department of Public Works</u> Specifications for Annual Bid for Pavement Markings

I. Invitation to Bid

- 1. The Town of Hanover acting through its Director of Public Works is accepting sealed bids from responsible and responsive parties to supply material, labor and equipment to perform placement of pavement markings in quantities as ordered on Town roads and properties in accordance with the following specification during the period of July 1, 2020 through June 30, 2021, with options to extend the contract for two additional years.
- 2. Sealed bids marked on the outside of the envelope "Bid for Pavement Markings" shall be accepted at the office of the Hanover Department of Public Works, 40 Pond Street, Hanover MA 02339 on the approved bid forms until 2:00 pm local time on May 28, 2020 at which time they will be opened and read aloud. All bidders must complete and submit the attached Non-Collusion Statement, Bidder's Certification Regarding Payment of Prevailing Wages, Tax Compliance Certificate, and Bidder's Qualification Form. Bids must include a 5% bid bond, a statement of compliance with Mass DOT standards for materials, and list of equipment intended for use in servicing this contract. Prequalification from Mass DOT is required. All bid forms must be either typewritten or written in ink. All signatures must be in ink.
- 3. Copies of this bid package may be viewed and/or downloaded from the Hanover DPW website at https://www.hanover-ma.gov/public-works/pages/open-bids-and-bid-results. Documents will be available after 12:00 PM on May 6, 2020. Hardcopies of bid packages can be made available at the Hanover Department Works with an advance request through 781-826-3189.
- 4. The Town of Hanover reserves the right to reject any or all bids should it be deemed in the best interest of the Town to do so.

II. General

- 1. Where listed in the specification, the word Engineer shall refer to the owner's representative.
- 2. The work shall consist of repainting existing lines, arrows, and other pavement markings on Town of Hanover roadways and parking areas as directed by the Town.
- Contractor shall provide adequate personnel, equipment, and supervision to properly execute the work of this contract. Personnel operating vehicles and equipment must be properly licensed for the safe and legal operation of the vehicles and equipment used.
- 4. The Town reserves the right to bid any item on this contract on a per job basis if, in the opinion of the Director of Public Works, the size and nature of the job is best handled as a separate construction contract or best handled in conjunction with a larger construction contract.
- 5. The Town reserves the right to perform work described in this contract using its own force labor if in the opinion of the Director of Public Works can be handled by said personnel within allocated resources.

III. Materials

- 1. Paint for contract groups 1 and 2 (normal paint) shall conform to the standards of the Massachusetts highway department. Specifically, materials shall conform to standard M7.01.10 (Fast Drying White waterborne traffic paint) and standard M7.01.11 (Fast Drying yellow water-borne traffic paint).
- 2. Reflectorized glass beads, if ordered by the Town, shall conform to standard M7.01.07 and shall be applied in accordance with the standards of the Massachusetts Highway Department.
- 3. Paint for contract group 3 (Thermoplastic) shall conform to the standards of the Massachusetts highway department. Specifically, materials shall conform to standard M7.01.03 (White Thermoplastic Reflectorized Pavement Markings) and standard M7.01.04 (Yellow Thermoplastic Reflectorized Pavement Markings).

IV. Construction Methods

- Paint shall be applied in accordance with the methods outlined in section 860 of the Massachusetts Highway
 Department 1995 Standard Specifications for Highways and Bridges. Paint shall be applied at a
 temperature of 4-50 degrees C at a minimum thickness of 0.4 mm above the pavement surface.
 Reflectorized glass beads, if ordered, shall be applied at .75 kg/l in accordance with the Mass Highway
 Standards.
- 2. Work shall take place as directed by the Town. The Town shall generally require the painting of center lines and fog lines at night. Parking lot painting shall take place so as to minimize disruption to building use night work may be required by the Town. The unit prices for all work shall be the same, whether the work is required at night or in the daylight hours.
- 3. Contractor shall exercise caution when applying detail paint items, coning off said items until the paint dries to prevent tracking by traffic.

V. Work Zone Protection

- 1. The Town shall provide at no cost to the contractor adequate police details, where necessary, for the protection of workers and to allow for the safe passage of traffic.
- 2. The contractor is responsible for all work zone signage and work zone protection he feels may be needed to adequately protect workers and motorists and the job site.

VI. Method of Measurement

- 1. For lines of all sizes that are painted, measurement shall be per linear foot of paint applied. Double centerlines shall be measured as two parallel lines. For all detail items, measurement shall be based on the units of measure listed on the bid form.
- 2. Quantities of detailed items listed are estimates only. The town reserves the right to adjust and or limit the quantities of work as needed at its sole discretion. Total quantities of detailed items actually applied shall be by mechanical measurement or by mutual agreement of both parties.

VII. Basis of Payment

1. Payment shall be based on a unit price basis times the quantity of lines/markings applied as determined by the Town

VIII. Pricing Structure and Rule for Award

1. Bidders shall quote unit prices for the items on the bid sheet. For the purpose of comparing bids, the bid sheets list estimated quantities, although actual quantities may differ.

- 2. One contract will be awarded will be awarded to the responsible and responsive bidder offering the lowest unit price per linear foot for general line painting which shall include center lines and fog lines.
- 3. A second contract will be awarded to the responsible and responsive bidder offering the lowest expected overall price for detail items (stop bars, "STOP" words, parking lot markings, miscellaneous detail markings, etc...) based on the estimated items on the bid sheet.
- 4. A third contract will be awarded to the responsible and responsive bidder offering the lowest expected overall price for new thermoplastic markings based on the estimated items on the bid sheet.
- 5. A secondary contract will be issued in each of the three categories of work to the second lowest responsible and responsive bidder in each category. The Town reserves the right to utilize these secondary contracts if primary vendor is unable to perform required work in a timely manner or if the Director of Public Works feels that the primary vendor has failed to deliver adequate quality and quantity of work as directed.
- 6. The Town reserves the right to adjust quantities as needed or to not paint certain items. All prices shall be considered unit prices.

IX. Contractor Qualifications

- 1. The Bidder must be a firm who has been regularly engaged in supplying similar services for a minimum of (5) years.
- 2. The Town reserves the right to reject any bid if the evidence submitted by, or the investigation of such Bidder fails to satisfy the Town that such Bidder is properly qualified to carry out the obligations of the Contract Documents and to complete the work contemplated herein.
- 3. Responsive Bidders must supply all the information requested. Incomplete or missing information will be cause for automatic rejection. The submittal shall be signed by an officer of the firm submitting the bid. Submittal from anyone else will be cause for automatic rejection. All exceptions taken to the specification and submittal requirements must be so stated in writing. Failure to do so will cause the Bid to be rejected.
- 4. The Town of Hanover has submitted a copy of the bid advertisement to Mass Highway. Prequalification from Massachusetts Highway Department is required.

X. Prevailing Wages

1. The contractor must pay all personnel involved in installation activities covered by this agreement the prevailing local union wage for such activities. The prevailing wage rates as determined by the Commonwealth of Massachusetts, Department of Labor, Division of Occupational Safety are attached. The contractor must provide certified documentation of payroll to document such wages were paid.

XI. Bonds

- 1. Pursuant to MGL Chapter 30 section 39M, proposals must be accompanied by a properly certified check or bid bond in the amount of 5% of the proposed price for the estimated quantities listed on the bid form, payable to the Town of Hanover.
- 2. A 50% Payment Bond will be required if awarded the contract. A cash surety is acceptable for the 50% payment bond. Basis for the payment bond shall be based on unit prices times the estimated quantities on the bid sheet.

XII. Insurance

- 1. Workmen's Compensation Insurance, Disability, Unemployment Compensation
 - A. The vendor will provide and maintain, and shall require its subcontractors to provide and maintain, all required insurance for its employees, including disability, worker's compensation, and unemployment compensation, in accordance with the laws of the Commonwealth of Massachusetts.
- 2. Motor Vehicle and General Liability Insurance
 - A. The vendor shall provide and maintain, and shall require its subcontractors to provide and maintain appropriate motor vehicle and comprehensive general liability insurance covering property damage and personal injuries in amounts equal to or greater than those currently carried by the Town. The current minimum amounts shall be general liability of at least \$1,000,000 bodily injury and property damage liability per occurrence and \$2,000,000 aggregate. The minimum amounts of automobile liability insurance shall be at least \$1,000,000 bodily injury and property damage per accident. The vendor and any subcontractor it uses, shall provide the Town of Hanover with certificates of insurance evidencing the insurance required by this paragraph, which shall name the Town as an "additional insured" and include a thirty day notice of cancellation to the Town.

XIII. Optional Contract Renewals

The Town of Hanover shall have the sole option to renew this contract for two additional one year periods. This option shall be exercised in writing. For option year 1 (July 1, 2021 – June 30, 2022), this renewal shall be exercised between 3/1/2021 and 6/15/2021. For option year 2 (July 1, 2022 – June 30, 2023), this renewal option shall be exercised between 3/1/2022 and 6/15/2022. Should the Town exercise its renewal option, we will entertain price adjustments based on changes to the prevailing wages.

XIV. Special Notes

The contract shall take extra care to calibrate measuring devices and shall submit job sheets, signed under the penalties of perjury, that quantities are accurate. The Town will review quantities prior to paying bills. Inaccurate quantities may become reason to reject work or to reject a vendor's future bids as nonresponsible.

Due to the use of roadways and various facilities, work may be scheduled at any time of day or night, weekdays or weekends, as directed by the Town to minimize inconvenience to the public. Night and or weekend work shall be charged at the same rate as daytime and weekday work.

XV. Bid Form

The undersigned hereby proposes to the Town of Hanover and agrees to provide labor, materials, and equipment to perform pavement marking services on various town roads and properties in quantities as ordered in accordance with the following specification during the period of July 1, 2020 through June 30, 2021, with options to renew for two additional one year periods. In submitting a bid I acknowledge I have obtained any addenda and fully understand the scope of work and conditions listed in this specification. This bid and the accompanying specification shall be considered an integral part of any contract awarded between the Town of Hanover and the lowest responsible and responsive bidder(s).

Information about Prevailing Wage Schedules for Awarding Authorities and Contractors

- This wage schedule applies only to the specific project referenced at the top of this page and uniquely identified by the "Wage Request Number" on all pages of this schedule.
- An Awarding Authority must request an updated wage schedule from the Department of Labor Standards ("DLS") if it has not opened bids or selected a contractor within 90 days of the date of issuance of the wage schedule. For CM AT RISK projects (bid pursuant to G.L. c.149A), the earlier of: (a) the execution date of the GMP Amendment, or (b) the bid for the first construction scope of work must be within 90-days of the wage schedule issuance date.
- The wage schedule shall be incorporated in any advertisement or call for bids for the project as required by M.G.L. c. 149, § 27. The wage schedule shall be made a part of the contract awarded for the project. The wage schedule must be posted in a conspicuous place at the work site for the life of the project in accordance with M.G.L. c. 149 § 27. The wages listed on the wage schedule must be paid to employees performing construction work on the project whether they are employed by the prime contractor, a filed sub-bidder, or any sub-contractor.
- All apprentices working on the project are required to be registered with the Massachusetts Department of Labor Standards, Division of Apprentice Standards (DLS/DAS). Apprentice must keep his/her apprentice identification card on his/her person during all work hours on the project. An apprentice registered with DAS may be paid the lower apprentice wage rate at the applicable step as provided on the prevailing wage schedule. Any apprentice not registered with DLS/DAS regardless of whether or not they are registered with any other federal, state, local, or private agency must be paid the journeyworker's rate for the trade.
- The wage rates will remain in effect for the duration of the project, except in the case of multi-year public construction projects. For construction projects lasting longer than one year, awarding authorities must request an updated wage schedule. Awarding authorities are required to request these updates no later than two weeks before the anniversary of the date the contract was executed by the awarding authority and the general contractor. For multi-year CM AT RISK projects, awarding authority must request an annual update no later than two weeks before the anniversary date, determined as the earlier of: (a) the execution date of the GMP Amendment, or (b) the execution date of the first amendment to permit procurement of construction services. Contractors are required to obtain the wage schedules from awarding authorities, and to pay no less than these rates to covered workers. The annual update requirement is not applicable to 27F "rental of equipment" contracts.
- Every contractor or subcontractor which performs construction work on the project is required to submit weekly payroll reports and a Statement of Compliance directly to the awarding authority by mail or email and keep them on file for three years. Each weekly payroll report must contain: the employee's name, address, occupational classification, hours worked, and wages paid. Do not submit weekly payroll reports to DLS. A sample of a payroll reporting form may be obtained at http://www.mass.gov/dols/pw.
- Contractors with questions about the wage rates or classifications included on the wage schedule have an affirmative obligation to inquire with DLS at (617) 626-6953.
- Employees not receiving the prevailing wage rate set forth on the wage schedule may report the violation to the Fair Labor Division of the office of the Attorney General at (617) 727-3465.
- Failure of a contractor or subcontractor to pay the prevailing wage rates listed on the wage schedule to all employees who perform construction work on the project is a violation of the law and subjects the contractor or subcontractor to civil and criminal penalties.
