


Ice Breaker

Fiscal Year End Appropriations. \$100K Use or Loose!

- Committee members made site reviews all along Rte. 139
- Recommendations to Town Manager:
 - Purchase five sets of solar powered pedestrian controls
 - Prep and resurface all stop bars and cross walks
- Initially, pedestrian controls will be installed across Rte. 139 at:
 - Town Hall
 - Between Curtis Free Library and Stetson House
 - Sylvester School at Veterans Memorial
 - Sylvester Field at outdoor recreational area (Tennis, Basketball)
 - Saint Mary's Church at Bittersweet Lane


Solar Powered Pedestrian Controls

Grove Street Safety Improvements

- Right turn only. North & south ends
- Five-week advance notification using social media and message boards – June 16th
- Most accidents occur crossing Rte. 139 and lefthand turns
- Six-month review in January
- If necessary, further adjustments can be made

Plain Street Safety Improvements

Will be making line of sight recommendations

Currently working on speed mitigations

- Considerations for the south side include:
 - Right turn only
 - No crossing Rte. 139 from either side using signage
 - Signalization
 - Shut down south side of Plain Street

Other Active Initiatives

- Inventory of speed and reductions. Last set = 1971
- Recommendations for cross walk configurations/maintenance
- West Hanover = Re-signalization & roadway configuration
- All intersecting streets for line-of-sight clearings
- Assisting Town Manager & DPW with SOW, RFP and RFQ
- Facilitate public engagement
- Collaborate with Mass DOT project for Hanover Center Project #612769 for \$6.1M
- Assist Town Manager with ongoing and new requests
