

TOWN OF HANOVER BYLAW REVIEW COMMITTEE NOTICE OF PUBLIC HEARING

Notice is hereby given that the Bylaw Review Committee of the Town of Hanover will hold a Public Hearing on Wednesday April 1, 2015 at 7:00p.m. at John Curtis Free Library, Hearing Room, 534 Hanover St., Hanover, MA.

The purpose of the Public Hearing is to hear testimony and comment from interested persons relative to proposed amendments and additions to General Bylaws for the Town of Hanover, said amendments to be included as Articles on the Warrant for consideration and action at the Annual Town meeting to be convened at the Hanover High School on Monday, May 4, 2015. After the Public Hearing the Committee will, as required by law, vote its recommendations on the proposed articles and report them to Town Meeting.

There are six articles proposed for consideration at the Annual Town Meeting. A summary of the proposed articles is provided below. Copies of the text of such Articles are available for review by interested parties in the Offices of the Town Clerk, 550 Hanover St., Hanover, MA., 02339 during regular business hours. The articles appearing below may not be the same as those on the final Warrant for the upcoming Town Meeting, and are inserted herein for convenience and discussion purposes only.
