 - a. Fireworks Site- A 10/13/21 Conditional Approval was received regarding the Scope of Work and Cost Estimate to prepare a Phase IV Remedy Implementation Plan (RIP) for the site. This approval gives authorization to Tetra Tech to implement the Scope of Work subject to DEP's conditions, including documentation for engineering concepts and design criteria to be used in the design and construction of the Final Remedy as well as required construction plans and specifications, and a best estimate schedule for implementation. In addition, requests for reimbursement and payments for costs, and similar, associated with preparation and implementation of the phase IV RIP in accordance with the terms of the Modified Interim Funding Protocol (MIFP) were included. To answer questions from the Commission regarding a recent on-site inspection that was held with various MA agencies, Board of Selectmen members, and others, this event was not scheduled through the Conservation Office, nor has any information regarding the event been provided.
 - b. Hanover Crossing- Erosion control and similar BMP reports have been received throughout the month with no issues at the site.
