1775 Washington Street (Hanover Crossing) – ANR – PB 22-6

The Board will review an Approval Not Required (ANR) plan for 1775 Washington Street (Hanover Crossing) which will create four (4) separate lots. Lot 1 – Buffalo Wild Wings – 69,491 square feet.

Lot 2 – Chipotle – 28,721 square feet.

Lot 3 - existing ATM location – 41,129 square feet.

Lot 4 – Hanover Crossing – 81 acres

Public Hearing - 1988 Washington Street (Valvoline) - PB 22-2

The Board will open a public hearing for Henley Enterprises, Inc. The applicant is requesting a Special Permit/Site Plan Review for 1988 Washington Street (Valvoline) to modify the existing 3,309 SF building with the demolition of approximately 969 SF of the existing building to the rear, formerly utilized as a car rental operation. Exterior modifications of the site and building include; additional pavement and landscaping in the portion of the demolished footprint and along the south side of the main building an addition (80 SF) for a second means of egress. Interior reconfiguration within the main building includes an additional bay, increased oil storage in basement and first floor office, employee area and restrooms areas.
