1. Road Safety Audit AND the Intersection Control Evaluation are completed.
2. Update from Greg Lucas, Tighe & Bond: Intersection Control Evaluation (ICE) Stage 2
 - By David Sawin: Timelines, Center Street, Signalization, Rotary(s)
3. Continue to review short term solutions, Route 139 Main Street/Center/Street/and Silver Street Road
 - Land Use Management. - Town Hall and Library driveways. *Wait for geometric studies, future discussions and considerations. This is also up for discussion in **March by the District 5, OCPC and Tighe & Bond***
 - Signage and Pavement Markings. - STOP sign for the eastern two-way road intersecting Main at Center St – DPW, HPD. Replace street sign name for the west leg of Center – DPW.
 - **Update from Kurt Kelley - Signage (stop sign and street name signs) have been ordered for Center Street as requested. These will be installed once received & weather cooperates. Pavement markings (stop bar) will be installed in the Spring.**
 - Eliminate the passing zone along Rte. 139 west of Center St – DPW and or Mass DOT – **PENDING**

- Schools. - Review school zone signage, Sign up for the Safe Routes to School Program, Provide safety education within schools – *Review for appropriateness by team members*
 1. **Update by Kurt Kelley - Safe Routes to School** – I’ve registered for a Webinar in late January that will review the SRTS Program details. We have also been in touch with a MassDOT Outreach Coordinator to discuss program offerings and how the program can specifically benefit the Town. Following the webinar and further conversation with the Coordinator, I will be speaking with the School Superintendent, Safety Officer, and Town Manager to discuss the potential of the Town joining the Program.

- Visibility. - Gateway concept – *Budgets, banners, signage, Historical Society.* – **PENDING**

- Pedestrian Accommodation. - Install Town-procured RRFB for the five crosswalks across Rte. 139, Update crosswalk signage through the Town center. **Incorporate into the first build and designs.**

- Review Landscaping at Town Pump
 1. **Update from Kurt Kelley - We reviewed the sight lines at Center Street/139 (Town Hall Side) with Safety Officer. There did not appear to be an impact from the bushes located within the lot across from the Fire Station/Town Hall Driveway. No action was deemed necessary at this time.**
