IV New Items

1. Grove Street Update – message boards are in place - waiting for metal signage for DPW
2. Request line-of-sight clearings at all intersections – DPW and/or Mass DOT
3. Speed Limits and Zones. Committee to draft a letter recommending reducing speed limits and zones along Rte. 139. Town Manager review, then out to OCPC and MassDOT. - **V**
4. Committee to send recommendations to Town Manager and Select Board for pedestrian cross walk configurations. Considerations - type, design, color, maintenance and cost with DPW concurrence. - **V**
5. West Hanover – tie into approved and funded Rail Trail Project for updated signaling - **V**
6. Public Engagement Process - We will wait until the Town has one or more designs for review
7. MassDOT District 5 - Project Eligibility Letter - 612769 = We will invite the state legislative and PM to our August 23rd meeting for a presentation
