3. **BL 15-44, SE 31-____, 357 Columbia Rd.-** NOI- for parking lot expansion & stormwater improvements in BZ to BVW

<u>PRESENT:</u> John Cavanaro, PE, Cavanaro Consulting, Applicant's Representative <u>DISCUSSION:</u> Mr. Cavanaro pointed out that only a portion of the project is proposed within 100 ft. of a Bordering Vegetated Wetland. Work within the buffer zone includes a 320 sq. ft. extension to the existing paved access roadway leading to the rear of the existing building and the installation of a swale for stormwater treatment. He noted that a waiver was issued by the Zoning Board of Appeals to reduce the number of required parking spaces, which resulted in an overall reduction of impervious area. Also that approval of the stormwater management design has been given by the Planning Board's Engineering Consultant, David Nyman, PE and that the redesign of the rear access way is proposed to meet safety requirements of the Fire Dept.

<u>VOTE:</u> Upon a motion and second made by Commissioners Brierley and McLoone, it was voted 4-0-0 to close the hearing.

Upon a motion and second made by Commissioners Brierley and Satterwhite, it was voted 4-0-0 to issue an Order of Conditions with the following special conditions:

a. Conservation posts are to be installed as per the Agent;
