

These are the minutes from the August 6, 2013 meeting of the Hanover Board of Health. Present were Mr. John Dougherty – Chair, Mr. Richard Farwell – Board Member, Mr. Anthony Marino – Health Agent, and Mr. Arthur Ceurvels – Assistant Health Agent / Inspector.

Having a quorum, Mr. Dougherty called the meeting to order at 6:20 p.m.

New Business

Meeting Minutes:

Mr. Farwell moved to approve the July 23, 2013 minutes as written, Mr. Dougherty second the motion; so voted unanimously.

Permits:

The following 2013 permits were signed;

- Title V Disposal Works Installer's Permit for Thomas Clancy, 10 Clayton Rd. Middleboro, MA
- Title V Disposal Works Installer's Permit for Paul Davis, 9 Rocky Lane, Cohasset, MA

26 Bates Way:

Mr. Farwell moved to authorize a request from Mr. S. David White, of 26 Bates Way for a reduction in setback requirements; for an additional (3rd) garage bay to be located 5.4' from the existing septic tank rather than the requisite of 10', and 16.7' distance for a proposed in-ground pool from the existing leaching field rather than the required 20'; Mr. Dougherty second the motion; so voted unanimously.

Mosquito Precaution:

Mr. Farwell moved to formalize the emergency order of Friday, August 2, 2013 closing all town recreational and school fields, from sunset to sunrise for organized sports activities, due to detection of mosquitos with WNV and EEE in Hanover. Mr. Dougherty second, so voted unanimously.

95 Ponderosa Drive – McGlone Enterprises, Inc.; Mr. Farwell moved to approve the plan originally date 7/9/13, revised 7/26/13 with variances as noted on the plan, Mr. Dougherty second the motion; so voted unanimously.

1054 Webster Street – McGlone Enterprises, Inc.; approved as submitted

213 Woodland Drive – McGlone Enterprises, Inc.; Mr. Farwell moved to approve the plan originally date 7/26/13, with variances as noted on the plan, Mr. Dougherty second the motion; so voted unanimously.

130 Colonial Drive – Clearwater Recovery; approved as submitted

272 Old Town Way – Grady Consulting; approved as submitted

Mr. Marino's update:

Mr. Marino stated that the department will be reaching out to Merrill Associates to get a performance update on the Dunkin Donuts' *White Knight* system, at 416 Columbia Rd.
