

These are the minutes from the March 8, 2016 meeting of the Hanover Board of Health. Present were Mrs. Lynn White – Chair, Mrs. Robin McLaughlin – Board Member, Mrs. Kimberly Dixon – Assistant Health Agent and Mrs. Joanne O'Connor – Administrative Assistant. Other attendees: Jennifer and Michael Reidy.

Having a quorum, Mrs. White called the meeting to order at 6:05 p.m.

New Business:

Meeting minutes from February 23, 2016 were not approved. Board member Mr. Farwell was unavailable and Mrs. McLaughlin had not attended.

Tick Smart Towns America: A civic program for engaging, educating, and empowering citizens to learn and know more about the dangers from ticks and how best to protect themselves. Mrs. White suggested that we should revisit this issue after more data is received.

Rabies Clinic: The annual Rabies Clinic will be held on Saturday, April 2, 2016 from 9 a.m. until noon at Town Hall.

Town of Hanover 2018 Master Plan: Mrs. McLaughlin has volunteered to join this committee.

Plans:

96 Cheryl Lane – McGlone Enterprises, Inc. - plans dated 02/20/16 were approved as submitted.

89 Walnut Street – McGlone Enterprises, Inc. - Mrs. McLaughlin motioned to approve plans dated 02/26/16 with a variance to allow the use of Soil Sieve Analysis to determine soil classification and assumed percolation rate and note the use of Presby Leaching Bed to reduce the required water table separation from 4.0' to 2.5' as allowed by the D.E.P., Mrs. White seconded, so voted unanimously.

8 Wood Hollow Way – Grady Consulting – plans dated 03/08/16 were approved as submitted.

119 Laurie Lane – Morse Engineering, Inc. - plans dated 03/02/16 (revised). Mrs. McLaughlin motioned to approve the plan to allow a setback reduction between the SAS and bordering vegetated wetland from 100' (required) to 74.4' (proposed), Mrs. White seconded, so voted unanimously.

Permits and Licenses signed by the Board.

Mrs. McLaughlin moved to adjourn, Mrs. White seconded, so voted unanimously. Meeting adjourned at 6:50 p.m.
