Job Posting Part Time Substitute Custodian (P3A)

The Hanover DPW Facilities Division is seeking persons with a strong work ethic who are interested in working as SUBSTITUTE CUSTODIANS in schools. A motivated and conscientious Substitute Custodian will have the opportunity to work at times up to 40 hours per week, primarily on the custodial 2nd shift (3-11 PM), but often on day shift as well. There is no obligation to accept particular assignments, as work opportunities would be offered according to your availability. This work involves all aspects of cleaning rooms in schools, including classrooms, offices, corridors, stairs and bathrooms. Tasks involve washing, wiping, sweeping, mopping, emptying trash, vacuuming, painting, operating cleaning machinery, simple outdoor groundskeeping, and lifting heavy objects. If you desire to do this detail-oriented work on a part-time basis that fits your schedule, we would love to talk to you.
